

**Celtic League AGM (20 - 21 October 2018) Resolutions Passed Renfield St Stephen's Centre, 260 Bath Street, Glasgow Alba.**

Éire:

1. Go n-aithníonn an Conradh Ceilteach Poblacht na Catalóine.

This AGM of the Celtic League recognises the right of the Catalan people to self determination. as evinced in the referendum held on 1 October 2017.

2. Go dtréasláinn an Conradh Ceilteach leo san a chothaigh fás na Gaelscolaíochta in Albain.

This AGM of the Celtic League congratulates those responsible for the growth of Gaelic Medium Education in Alba.

3. Go gcáineann an Conradh Ceilteach dí-bheartas Rialtas na hÉireann i dtaobh na Gaeilge agus na Gaeltachta de.

This AGM of the Celtic League condemns the Irish Government due to its inaction on and lack of support for the Irish language and the Gaeltacht.

Mannin

1. Recalling the resolutions adopted at the 2000 and 2017 Celtic League AGMs that condemned the forced removal, between 1966 and 1969 of the population of the Chagos Islands of Diego Garcia from their home by the British and American governments, as one of the most shameful examples of colonial exploitation;

Also being aware of the intimidating role that members of the British Army played in that deportation

This AGM calls upon the British Government and British Army:

(a) to reiterate the apology for the action on the Chagos Islands and also identify the personnel involved and the unit(s) to which they belonged.

(b) give credibility to the apology by allowing the return of the Chagos Islanders to their homes.

2. This AGM calls on the Scottish Parliament to commission an independent review into plans for dredging kelp around the coasts of Scotland, including their sustainability and effects on non-target species.
